I. General Information: Disclosures

The goods and services shown on the following pages are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you select.

This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery, grave opening, flowers and newspaper notices. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or the statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

II. Professional Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$1025.00

This is the basic charge to each family which we serve for our professional expertise in assisting them. It includes, but is not limited to, a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities, and business expenses necessary to serve the public in a professional manner. Also included in this charge is the consultation with the family, clerical and administrative services, preparation and filling of necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, assistance with planning the funeral or memorial services. There will be an additional charge for the direction and supervision of each service requested or required. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the cost of the funeral you select.

Notice: This fee or a portion of this fee that pertains to the service you select is already included in our charges for: direct cremations, immediate burials, forwarding and receiving remains, traditional and graveside services.

III. Embalming and Other Preparation of the Body

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

These services only include: Basic professional services of funeral director and staff, removal of remains from place of death within 20 mile service radius, (mileage charge of \$3.50 per loaded mile will apply if outside of service radius), transportation to cemetery, refrigeration, and placement in casket or alternative container.

Service does not include: Embalming and other preparation of remains other than what is mentioned above, use of facility and funeral home for service or visitation, automotive charges, memorial package or memorial items, cash advance items such as; cemetery fees, open / closing of grave, grave liner or vaults, tent or grave equipment, flowers or sales taxes.

X. Traditional Funeral Service \$3,095.00

This service includes but is not limited to: Basic professional services of funeral director and staff, removal of remains from place of death (within 20 mile service radius), embalming, dressing, casketing, cosmetology of remains, automotive equipment, (funeral coach, Service vehicle, one visitation period and funeral service in our chapel or other facility, funeral director and staff for supervising, directing and conducting funeral services.

This service does not include: Merchandise (casket, vault or grave liner, memorial items, register book, food register, acknowledgment cards, memorial memory folders, temporary markers for grave,) cash advance items such as; cemetery fees, opening and closing fees, obituary notices when there is a charge for them, flowers, taxes, additional hair care for the deceased, minister or musician gratuities or additional mileage charges for vehicles when conducting services outside a 20 mile service radius.

XI. Traditional Funeral Service with Cremation **\$3,195.00**

Purchaser has the option to add or delete any part of the service that is not needed or wanted.

XII. Direct Cremation **\$795.00 to \$5,290.00**

State and local laws do not require a casket for direct cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The container we provide is the basic alternative made of fiberboard and composition (cardboard) material.

- A. Direct cremation with basic alternative container \$ 795.00
- B. Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser \$ 845.00

Direct Cremation is the minimum service offered for disposition of remains. **This service includes:** Removal of remains from place of death (within 20 mile service radius) and transportation to the crematory, ascertaining proper information for vital statistics, filling out death certificate and file with Health Department, arranging for Medical examiner to examine remains, placing remains in an alternative container for cremation and crematory fee.

Service does not include: Use of facility and staff for visitation or memorial services, cemetery fees, or merchandise paid obituary notices, flowers, cash advances, or additional automotive equipment, memorial items, urns, medical examiner's fee.

XIII. Other Services

A. Graveside Services **\$2,995.00**

This service includes, but is not limited to: Basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, dressing, casketing and cosmetology of remains, removal of remains from institution of death (within 30 mile service radius), automotive equipment, one day visitation.

Service does not include: additional hair care of remains, additional automotive equipment, cash advance items, such as; paid obituary notices, flowers, cemetery fees (open and close grave), tent, grave equipment), casket or alternative container for burial, vault or grave liner if required by cemetery, any taxes or gratuities to ministers or musicians, memorial package or memorial items, such as; memorial memory folders, register books, food register, acknowledgment cards, temporary grave markers.

XIV. Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home **\$1,595.00**

This service only includes: removal (within 20 mile service radius), embalming, basic service charge of funeral director and staff, transportation local airport. If service requires additional charges, the fees will be discussed at conference with purchaser.

This service does not include: Merchandise used to ship remains on commercial transit such as: casket, combination containers or alternative containers, also commercial transit charges and receiving funeral directors charges are not included.

XV. Receiving Remains From Another Funeral Home **\$1,295.00**

This service includes: The basic services of the funeral director and staff, transportation from commercial transit (within 20 mile service radius) to funeral home or cemetery.

Service does not include: Embalming, other preparation of remains, facility charges for visitation, funeral, memorial service, additional automotive expenses, such as: flower vehicle, utility vehicle, lead car or limousine / family car, merchandise, casket, vault or grave liner, cemetery fees, opening and closing of grave, cash advances such as : paid obituary notices, death certificates, flowers, musician and ministers gratuities, or any taxes.
